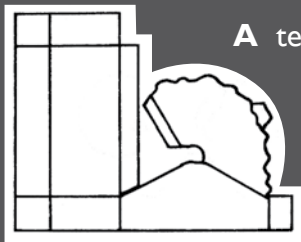
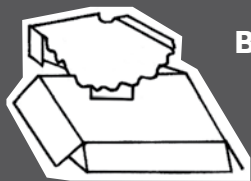


# Create your own model of Rangitoto

B folding pattern

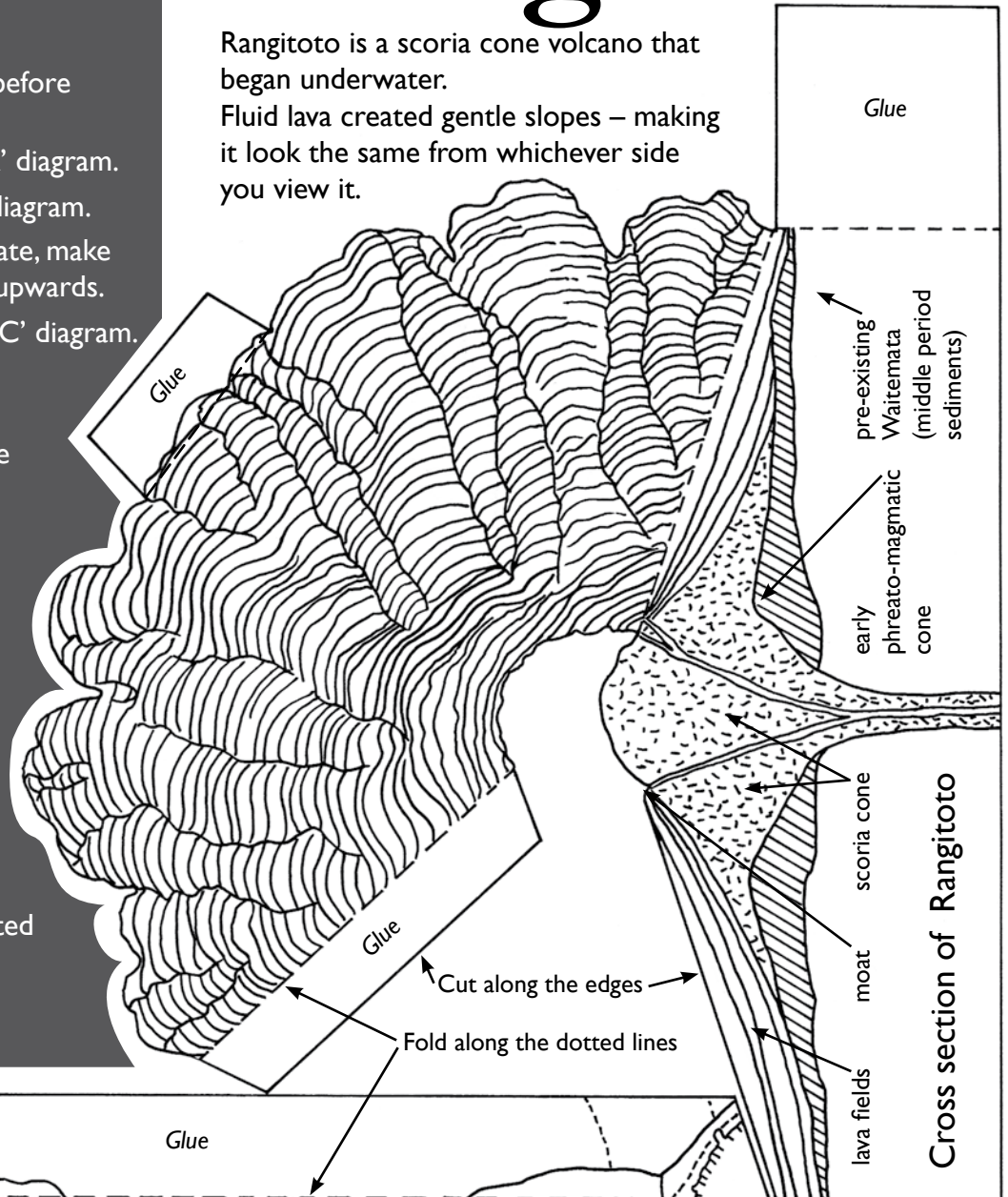


C completed scoria cone

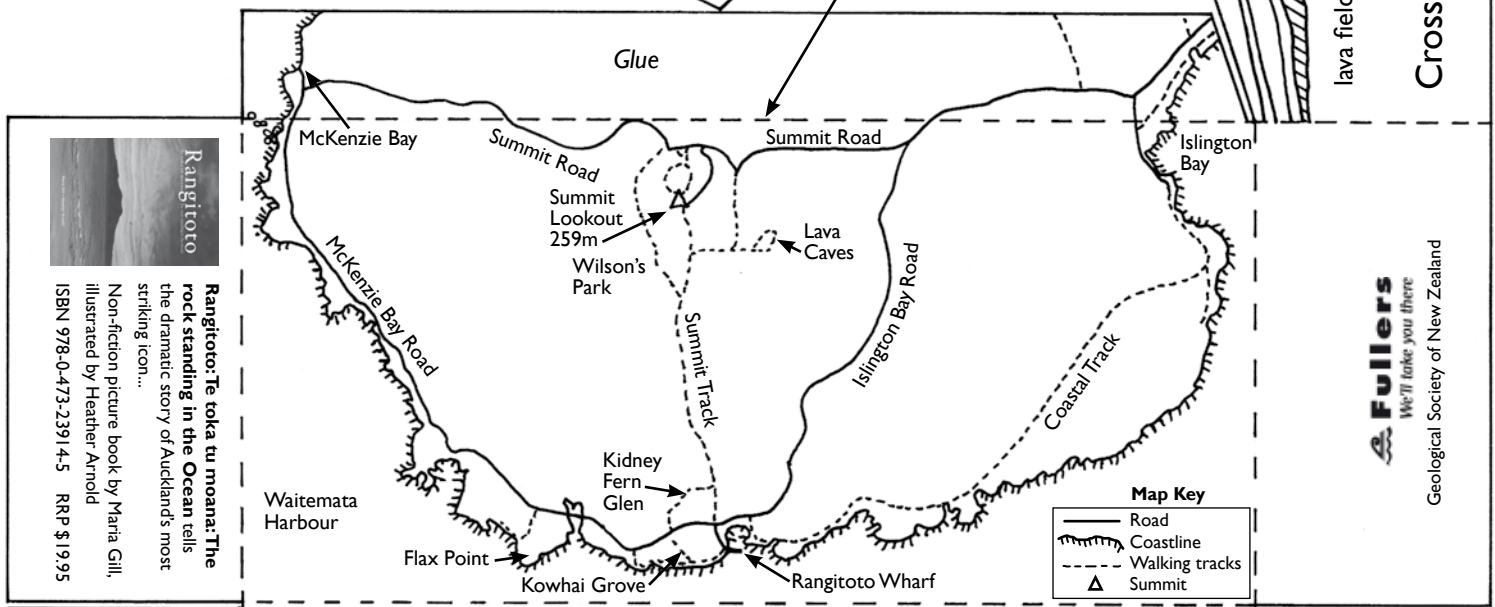
# Rangitoto
